FOX HUNT SPLASH NEEDS YOUR HELP!

The Fox Hunt Swim Team depends on a large number of volunteers to ensure a successful season. It takes over 40 volunteers to put one swimmer in the water for one meet. There were over 400 volunteer opportunities last year. We are very fortunate to have many parent volunteers. The commitment and dedication shown by the vast majority of our parent volunteers have been wonderful.

Included in this year's registration packet is a Volunteer Commitment Form. Listed on the form are the volunteer jobs that are available. You will rank the jobs in the order that you would prefer to work. All positions listed do not require prior experience or training. Swim team activities occur on various days of the week – not just Saturdays or Mondays. There are also a variety of times to choose from – some are morning activities and others are in the evening. All jobs will count as one meet or social credit with the exception of meet set up. A list of all meets and social activities are listed on the form for easy reference. Please review the form and fill out the information carefully.

Each family is **required** to volunteer for the following:

1. At least **five** separate meet functions (timer, concessions, clerk of course, etc), **one** of which has to be concessions
2. **One** social activity (TGIF, Teen Progressive Diner, etc.)
3. If your child is swimming in the Divisional Relay Carnival (July 13th), Divisionals (July 30th), Daventry IM Carnival (July 25th), and/or the Orange Hunt Invitational Relay Carnival (July 24th – tentative), you must be prepared to volunteer at these meets in addition to the minimum requirement.

If all of your swimmers are Mini Splash, please volunteer for **two** social events.

We want to give everyone the opportunity to sign up for the jobs and dates they want to work. There will be volunteer sign-up sheets at registration. (Please bring your calendar with you!) The volunteer coordinator will fill in any remaining jobs using the information on the Volunteer Commitment Form. **You will be assigned the date and job to work.**

Please feel free to add any comments to the form that will assist the volunteer coordinator in scheduling your family's volunteer assignment. The coordinator will do her best to match every family with their requests but in some instances, alternatives will have to be assigned. It is best to list as many volunteer positions as possible or to sign up on your own.

A volunteer roster will be posted at the pool by Wednesday morning to remind everyone who is assigned to what event that week. A reminder email will also be sent on Wednesday to those individuals. **Should a conflict arise with your scheduled volunteer assignment, it is your responsibility to find a replacement and notify Jill Schwabenbauer of the change:**
